

A Book of Remembrance is a lasting way to remember a loved one. At Masonhill Crematorium we have four handmade volumes, bound in vellum, richly hand-tooled and blocked in pure gold, on permanent display. Entries are also available to view permanently online.

Every Inscription is hand-written by skilled artists, with each inscription embellished with a raised gold initial letter, gilded with gold leaf, and finally burnished.

There is one page for each day of the year, with the book opened every day at the appropriate page. This allows entries to be seen on the anniversary of the date they were recorded.

Additional options to consider include the electronic Book of Remembrance which replicates the main message held in the book, with the option of adding additional pages; and Memorial Cards, which are suitable for sending to distant relatives and friends who may be unable to visit the crematorium.
