On Wed. 20/6/12, the Council made the above-named Orders in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Orders, which come into effect on Mon. 9/7/12, consolidate a number of existing Traffic Regulation Orders in South Ayrshire for the purposes of Decriminalised Parking Enforcement.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirements of the Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, may, within six weeks from Fri. 22/6/12, apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (SCOTLAND) ACT 1997, AS AMENDED BY THE PLANNING ETC. (SCOTLAND) ACT 2006 TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (CONTROL OF ADVERTISEMENTS) (SCOTLAND) REGULATIONS 1984 ROADS (SCOTLAND) ACT 1984

Under the provisions of the above legislation the Council may take direct action to remove unauthorised signage (including trailers, placards and posters). Recovery of all costs incurred may be relevant.

(BOSWELL PARK AND ARTHUR STREET, AYR) (TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ACCESS) ORDER 2012

On 11/6/12 the Council made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended. The Order makes it unlawful for any person to cause, or permit to be caused, any vehicle (except emergency service vehicles) to contravene the restrictions.

The order comes into operation 00:01hrs, Mon 18/6/12 until 23:59hrs Mon 2/7/12.

VARIOUS ROADS, AYR TOWN CENTRE (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) (WATER MAINS REHABILITATION) ORDER 2012 _

The Council, made this Order on 15/6/12 under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended. The Order make it unlawful for any person to cause, or permit to be caused, any vehicle (except vehicles engaged in water mains rehabilitation works) to contravene the restrictions.

The order comes into operation 00:01hrs, Mon 25/6/12 until 23:59hrs Sun 2/12/12 or until works are completed, whichever is earlier.

(VARIOUS ROADS, COYLTON) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 201_

The Council, propose to introduce an Order to introduce waiting restrictions within Coylton.
