On Wed. 1/8/12, the Council made the above-named Orders in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Orders, which come into effect on Sat. 1/9/12, will allow all of the existing Waiting/ Parking Restrictions detailed in the above Orders in South Ayrshire to be enforced by the Council using the powers of Decriminalised Parking enforcement. Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirements of the Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, may, within six weeks from Fri 17/8/12, apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.

THE ROAD TRAFFIC (PERMITTED PARKING AREA AND SPECIAL PARKING AREA) (SOUTH AYRSHIRE COUNCIL) DESIGNATION ORDER 2012.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that SOUTH AYRSHIRE COUNCIL in accordance with section 74 of the Road Traffic Act 1991 as amended, and The Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (South Ayrshire Council) Designation Order 2012, (Statutory Instrument 2012 No. 140), will introduce Penalty Charge and Reduced Penalty Charge levels and additional parking charges as indicated in the Schedule below. The Council intends to use these powers with effect from 1st September 2012 and therefore the charges will apply within the Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Areas as specified in the above Statutory Instrument from this date.

A Penalty Charge Notice will be issued to a vehicle which is in contravention of a regulation order either on-street or in a Council off-street car park.

SCHEDULE.

The relevant charges for on-street contraventions are:-

(i) a penalty charge of £60 on the issue of a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN) in accordance with Section 66 of the 1991 Act but discounted to £30 if payment is received within 14 days of the issue of the PCN;

(ii) on the issue of a "Charge Certificate" in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 6 of Schedule 6 to the 1991 Act the penalty charge shall be increased to the sum of £90.

(iii) Release Fee for Removed Vehicles, £105.00 (iv) Storage of Vehicle Fee, £12.00 per 24 hour period (or part thereof) (v) Disposal of Vehicle Fee, £ 50.00

The relevant charges for off-street (car park) contraventions are:-

(vi) a penalty charge of £60 on the issue of a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN) in accordance with Section 66 of the 1991 Act but discounted to £30 if payment is received within 14 days of the issue of the PCN;

(vii) on the issue of a "Charge Certificate" in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 6 of Schedule 6 to the 1991 Act the penalty charge shall be increased to the sum of £90.
