What the children say

TRAVEL ISSUES / CONCERNS

What the parents say

We also carried out parent questionnaires to find out what parents, pupils and guardians feel about the journey to our school.

The following concerns were raised:

- Too many cars being driven to school - concerns about pollution.
- Too many cars parking near school gates making it dangerous to cross the road.
- Cars travelling too fast along Back Road.
- No safe crossing at Coleman's brae – due to too many parked cars.
- No safe place to cross near co-op due to delivery lorries and cars.
- No foot path or markings by the Monument.
- Speeding traffic on Hadyard Terrace and Eldington.
- Pathway between Church Cres and Back Road - children can't be seen.

Improvements/Requested Solutions.

- Speed table on Back Road/and by Co-op.
- Safe crossing route at the Monument.
- 'No parking on Zig-zags' banner.
