Question 1 What do you think about the existing school estate in Maybole? Please use the box below to record your response.

- Like Carrick the way it is but could do with refurbishment and made brighter
- Primaries cramped , create one large primary
- New Secondary and new large Primary
- How can they afford to knock down and build new ones as they say they don't have any money
- Existing schools too old and small
- Bring P6&P7s up to Carrick
- making age range 10- 18
- Classrooms are too small
- Old building at Carrick is fine New building is in state of disrepair, demolish new building and rebuild
- Concerned that school is so near main road, by-pass should be in place

Question 2 What should the school estate in Maybole look like in the future? Please use the box below to record your comments and ideas.

- Response
- Do not think the schools should join together
- Think all the schools should be together big new building
- Keep Carrick as is and create one large primary and put all primaries together
- Concerned about younger pupils walking all the way up to Carrick
- New large school for all but re-locate centrally away from main road
- Keep primaries separate but build new bigger Carrick Academy
- Stay the way it is but modernise Carrick and new equipment
- Solar panels
- Automatic doors
- New Carrick and new big primary
- Carrick needs to be cleaner
