

**(JUNCTION RECONSTRUCTION WORKS)  
(BELMONT AVENUE AT BELMONT ROAD JUNCTION,  
AYR)  
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2008**

On the 9th day of May 2008, South Ayrshire Council made an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will make it unlawful for:-

Any person to drive, or cause, or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on junction reconstruction works) on that part of Belmont Avenue, Ayr at its junction with Belmont Road.

Between the following times: -

From 07.00 hours on Friday 23rd May 2008 and will remain in operation until 20.00 hours on Wednesday 28th May 2008, or until such time as the works are complete, whichever is the earlier.

**ALTERNATIVE ROUTES**

1. Vehicles wishing to access Belmont Avenue from Belmont Road should proceed eastwards along Belmont Road to its junction with Meadowpark and then northwards along Meadowpark to its junction with Chalmers Road and then westwards along Chalmers Road to its junction with Belmont Avenue.
2. Vehicles wishing to access Belmont Road from Belmont Avenue should proceed in the reverse direction.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

**(VARIOUS ROADS IN SOUTH AYRSHIRE)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITIONS AND SPEED  
RESTRICTION) ORDER 2008**

On the 12th day of May 2008, South Ayrshire Council made an Order under Sections 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers enabling them in that behalf, being satisfied that the traffic on the roads specified in the Order hereto should be restricted, or prohibited, as hereinafter provided because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the following roads :-

The Order will apply to the specified roads from time to time as indicated by appropriate traffic signs and the effect will be to impose temporary prohibitions on the use, or on overtaking, or to impose temporary speed restrictions.

The Order will come into force at 00:00 hours on Saturday 17th May 2008 and will remain in operation until 24:00 hours on Monday 16th November 2009.

## **(WELLINGTON SQUARE, CASSILLIS STREET, A719 WHITLETTS ROAD, HAWKHILL AVENUE AND B747 CRAIGIE ROAD, AYR) (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2008**

On the 6th day of May 2008, South Ayrshire Council made an Order under Section 62 of the Roads Scotland Act 1984, as amended, which will make it unlawful for :-

### **1. Prohibition of Loading / Waiting**

1.1 Any person to cause, or permit any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the Burns Festival Event) to wait adjacent to the south kerbline of **Wellington Square North**, from a point 20 metres, or thereby west of the central access point to the Wellington Square Gardens, to a point 20 metres, or thereby east of said access, or as indicated by 'no waiting at any time' traffic cones, between the following times :-

- From 06:00 hours on Sun 11th May until 22:00 hours on Mon 26th May 2008, inclusive.

1.2 Any person to cause, or permit any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the Burns Festival Event) to wait adjacent to the north kerbline of **Wellington Square South**, from its junction with Fort Street to a point 40 metres, or thereby west of said junction, or as indicated by 'no waiting at any time' traffic cones, between the following times :-

- From 06:00 hours on Sun 11th May until 22:00 hours on Mon 26th May 2008, inclusive.

1.3 Any person to cause, or permit any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the Burns Festival Event) to wait adjacent to the south kerbline of **Wellington Square North**, from its junction with Fort Street to the central access point to the Wellington Square Gardens

- From 06:00 hours until 23:59 hours on Sat 17th May 2008

1.4 Any person to cause, or permit any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the Burns Festival Event) to wait adjacent to the north kerbline of **Wellington Square South**, from its junction with Fort Street to the central access point to the Wellington Square Gardens

- From 06:00 hours until 23:59 hours on Sat 17th May 2008

### **2. Prohibition of Specified Turns**

2.1 Any person to drive, or cause, or permit to be driven any motor vehicle, so as to make a turn from the roads specified in column 1, to the roads specified in column 2, during the hours of 22:00 – 23:59 hrs during Sat. 24th May 2008.

#### **Column 1**

Length of road in South Ayrshire

- (1) Whitletts Road (A719) eastbound.
- (2) Westernmost exit road (private) from Ayr Racecourse car park.
- (3) Hawkhill Avenue (unclassified)
- (4) Whitletts Road (A719) westbound at its junctions with Craigie Road (B747) and Burnett Terrace (unclassified).
- (5) Whitletts Road (A719) westbound at its junction with Russell Drive (unclassified).
- (6) Car park exit road (private), (western side of Craigie Road (B747)).
- (7) Racecourse Inner Area car park exit road (private), (eastern side of Craigie Road (B747)).

#### **Column 2**

Length of road in South Ayrshire

- Westernmost access road (private) to Ayr Racecourse car park.
- Whitletts Road (A719) eastbound.
- Whitletts Road (A719) westbound
- Whitletts Road (A719) eastbound
- Whitletts Road (A719) eastbound
- Craigie Road (B747) southbound
- Craigie Road (B747) northbound

### **3. Road Closures**

3.1 Any person to drive, or cause, or permit to be driven any motor vehicle, (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the Burns Festival Event) on that part of **Cassillis Street**, from its junction with Wellington Square South to its junction with Wellington Square North, between the following times :-

From 06:00 hours on Sat 24th May until 20:00 hours on Sun 25th May 2008, as indicated by temporary signing.

### **4. Diversion Route for Closure of Cassillis Street**

4.1 Vehicles wishing to access Wellington Square North from Wellington Square South should proceed by way of Pavilion Road in a westerly direction to its junction with The Esplanade, thence continue by way of The Esplanade in a northerly direction to its junction with Bath Place, thence continue by way of Bath Place in an easterly direction to access Wellington Square North. Vehicles wishing to access Wellington Square South from Wellington Square North should proceed in the opposite direction.

Contravention of the Order, which may be inspected at Roads and Transportation, Burns House, Burns Statue Square, Ayr could result in a penalty of up to £100.
