**CIVIC GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 1982 AND TRANSPORT ACT 1985 METERED FARES FOR TAXIS AND PRIVATE HIRE CARS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT South Ayrshire Council under the review procedure laid down by Section 17 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 and Section 14 of the Transport Act 1985 intend to review the maximum fares for the hire of taxis and private hire cars using taxi meters and other charges in connection therewith. Accordingly it is proposed that with effect from **15/1/16** the **maximum** fares and charges will be unchanged and will remain as follows:- Distance not exceeding 1180 yards or for a time not exceeding 4 minutes 40 seconds **£2.80**. Each additional 80 yards or 24 seconds **£0.10**. Night time Charge (12 midnight - 6 a.m.) per hire **£1.00**. Each completed period of 48 seconds **£0.20**. Fouling Charge **£60.00**. Christmas and New Year (From 9 p.m. on 24th December - 6 a.m. on 27th December and from 9 p.m. on 31st December - 6 a.m. on 3rd January) **X 1.5**. 6/7/8 Seater vehicles - Where six, seven or eight passengers are carried an enhanced charge of **X 1.5**. Fares for the shared hire of metered vehicles and all other charges in connection with the shared hire of metered vehicles, or with the arrangements for their shared hire, shall not be greater than those above.
