**The South Ayrshire Council (Restriction of Permitted
Development) (Ayr II Extension, Troon and Southwood
Conservation Areas) Direction 2006**

South Ayrshire Council in terms of article 4(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (Scotland) Order 1992 (SI 1992/223) being satisfied that it is expedient that development comprising the Classes of Permitted Development specified in the First Schedule hereto should not be carried out within the areas of land described in the Second Schedule hereto unless permission is granted on an application in that behalf, hereby directs that the permission granted by Article 3 in respect of the Classes of Permitted Development specified in the said First Schedule shall not apply to the areas of land described in the said Second Schedule.

This Direction may be cited as the South Ayrshire Council (Restriction of Permitted Development) (Ayr II Extension, Troon and Southwood Conservation Areas) Direction 2006.
