

**LOW ROAD, AYR (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS)  
(SCOTTISH POWER NETWORK UPGRADE  
WORKS) ORDER 2012**

The Council, made this Order on 12/6/12 under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended. The Order make it unlawful for any person to cause, or permit to be caused, any vehicle (except vehicles engaged in Scottish Power Network Upgrade works) to contravene the restrictions.

The order comes into operation 00:01hrs, Mon 23/7/12 until 23:59hrs, Fri 24/8/12 or until works are completed, whichever is earlier.

**DOONHOLM ROAD & ALLOWAY (SCOTTISH  
WATER MAINS RELAYING WORKS)**

Works commence Thu 19/7/12 until Fri 27/7/12, on the cycle path between Doonfoot Rd and Alloway and will require closure of the cycle path.

**(A719 THE TURNBERRY - AYR - GALSTON ROAD)  
(VARIOUS RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2012**

On 16/7/12 the Council made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended. The Order makes it unlawful for any person to cause, or permit to be caused, any vehicle (with the exception of vehicles connected with the Senior Open Golf Championship at Turnberry Golf Club) to contravene the restrictions. The order comes into operation on 23/7/12 until 30/7/12.

**(VARIOUS ROADS NORTHFIELD & HEATHFIELD  
AREAS, AYR) (TEMPORARY WAITING/LOADING  
RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2012**

On 16/7/12 the Council made this Order under Section 62 of the Roads Scotland Act 1984. The Order makes it unlawful for any person to cause, or permit to be caused, any vehicle to contravene the restrictions. The order comes into operation on 24/7/12 until 29/7/12.
