| Girvan Community Garden | Girvan community garden provides a community space which creates volunteering opportunities for everyone, regardless of age and ability, to engage in horticultural sessions and community events throughout the year. A large percentage of our Green gym volunteers have learning difficulties and attend with a support worker. Presently there are limited areas where they can work in bad weather. Funding is sought to help build a shelter where we will be able to offer a spacious sheltered working area within the garden. | £1,000 | Fully Funded |
| The Town Team | The 'All will be Well' project's key objective will be to provide a safe place for males seeking 'mental wellbeing', an opportunity for good company, refreshments and to be informed of potential activities including the 'Relaxed Sports' opportunities and the Men's Shed. | £1,000 | Fully Funded |
| Club Diamonds | Our group provides keep fit classes in the three areas Girvan, Barrhill and Colmonell. We are a non-profit making organisation which has trained, qualified instructors. The committee know how important it is to have qualified staff to run a "taylor made" keep fit instruction.
