<b>Organisation</b>	<b>Summary of Project</b>	<b>Award</b>
<b>1st Crosshill Guides and Senior Section</b>	To run a series of outdoor activities over the course of a year which will give the girls a chance to try things they wouldn't otherwise have the chance to do.	£1,630.00
<b>Carrick &amp; Maybole Walking Football Group</b>	To help reduce the cost of the weekly walking football sessions, including transport costs to competitions, and to purchase equipment to enhance the quality of experience.	£800.00
<b>Carrick Canoe Club</b>	To help fund two junior kayaks and two intermediate kayaks, with associated equipment - paddles, buoyancy aids, helmets, spraydecks, cagoules and wetsuits.	£2,000.00
<b>Carrick Coastal Rowing Club</b>	To build a 'wet room' as part of the group's health & safety audit. This will provide cover and a warm shower within the boat house for possible hypothermia victims.	£1,800.00
<b>Carrick Senior Citizens Lunch Club</b>	To bring together a group of interested local people to look at providing information on the type of support required to help the growing number of people who have dementia related illnesses or other difficult life-changing domestic issues which cause hardship and isolation through being housebound or having reduced mobility.	£950.00
<b>Crosshill Village Club</b>	To help subsidise outings, theatre trips, guest speakers and running expenses.	£400.00
<b>Fisherton Church</b>	To build a peace garden and a sensory garden in the grounds of Fisherton Church which everyone in the community will be able to access.	£2,000.00
<b>Gardenrose Early Years Centre at the Carrick Centre</b>	To create an area within the playroom which is dedicated to sensory play. This would positively contribute to the experiences that children who attend receive and will enhance their development.	£2,000.00
<b>Martin's Fields</b>	To establish an allotment where children and young people can grow a range of plants, for their own use and for sale, during the school week as part of their education. They will also be able to develop their skills in fencing, animal care, the environment and cooking.	£1,794.00
<b>Maybole and North Carrick Villages Access/Communication Group</b>	To provide free basic dementia awareness training to local businesses, schools and groups in North Carrick who wish to participate.	£1,675.00

<b>Maybole Memorial Park Bowling Club</b>	To purchase an indoor bowling carpet and accessories so that club members and families can come together during the winter months to play bowls and maintain contact.	£1,700.00
<b>Maybole OAP's Association</b>	To part fund social outings for members to various events. These events give the members something to look forward to and help ease the loneliness and isolation felt by many who are not as mobile and don't get out much.	£1,500.00
<b>Maybole Recovery Group</b>	This funding would help to keep the doors open in Maybole for people who are seeking recovery from addiction. Funding would cover the general running costs, team building sessions, and allow the group to purchase a calor gas heater for the winter months.	£930.00
<b>Maybole Youth Club</b>	To host a celebration event that will include celebrating the achievements of young people from North Carrick (Dunure Youth Club, Kirkmichael Youth Club, Maybole Youth Club and Carrick Centre Youth Club). To run workshops and present certificates to young people who have gained an award over the past year.	£1,300.00
<b>Minishant Youth Club</b>	To fund the start up costs of providing a youth club. A grant award would fund the first year hall hire, games and crafts, tuck shop, insurances and PVG disclosure for volunteers.	£2,000.00
<b>NHS Ayrshire and Arran Cognitive Stimulation Therapy Group</b>	To start a group in Maybole to allow individuals with dementia to access beneficial and valuable therapy.	£1,203.11
<b>South Ayrshire Escape from Homelessness (SeAScape)</b>	To source goods in good condition and transport to clients, many of whom are socially isolated and have no family or friends, who have secured a tenancy but have no funds or furniture to make a fit for purpose home.	£2,000.00
<b>Straiton Indoor Bowling Club</b>	To replace the mats as they are over 50 years old. The club is in danger of closing if the mats are not replaced.	£1,400.00
<b>The Carrick Centre</b>	The Panto Project is an initiative which aims to encourage the education of drama to 30 primary 7 school pupils from Maybole. Working alongside professional actors and the centres youth work team, young people will take part in a 10-week programme to develop a FREE Christmas Pantomime that they will perform to their fellow peers, parents and the local community in December 2017.	£2,000.00
