GROUP	PROJECT SUMMARY	£	OUTCOME
<b>South Ayrshire Dementia Support Association - SADSAs</b>	To fund the redecorating of our Prestwick Centre, ensuring it is welcoming, well maintained and dementia-friendly. This will help create an environment to ensure clients feel valued, respected & safe.	£925	Funded
<b>Kyle Stroke Group</b>	To help fund weekly transport costs & support our stimulating activities programme. Many of our members have mobility issues, and although we manage to transport members using volunteer's cars we also need to hire a Community Transport bus, which is disability and wheelchair friendly.	£1000	Funded
<b>Crossroads</b>	This funding would enable us to offer extra care hours for local carers who need care above the minimum allocated by the Local Authority. We could also provide additional respite care for carers to attend appointments or family occasions.	£990	Funded
<b>Ayrshire Cancer Support</b>	Funding would help towards our counselling service within the Prestwick locality. Counselling provides the client with an opportunity to share their thoughts and feelings with a sensitive and responsive listener. It can help people to come to terms with their own illness or that of a loved one.	£1000	Funded
<b>Prestwick People Projects</b>	To help fund our Cycling Without Age Prestwick project, to ensure that we can continue to provide Trishaw rides within the Prestwick locality to help combat social isolation and improve health & wellbeing for those with mobility issues and long term health conditions within our local community	£1,000	Funded
<b>BSL Ayrshire</b>	To provide bursaries to parents of deaf children and people who are themselves losing their hearing, to learn British Sign Language. We would also like to offer free taster and top-up sessions in Prestwick, but require funding to help cover the costs of venue fees, resources, etc.	£1,000	Funded
<b>New Life Trust</b>	This funding would help us continue to provide our Diamonds Over 60s weekly Lunch Club. Diamonds is an opportunity to have a meal at an affordable price and an opportunity to meet with others in a social setting. For older people living on their own, both can be equally important	£1,000	Funded
<b>Beautiful Inside &amp; Out</b>	To fund much needed counselling. Schools, GPs, work places & individuals in Prestwick contact us seeking support by way of counselling, play therapy, drama therapy, music therapy or art therapy. Our counsellors can make immediate appointments for troubled people bereaved families of suicide victims.	£1,000	Funded

<b>A Space to Make Sense of School</b>	To help support our Sensory Bus, providing a mobile sensory provision to schools across the Prestwick & Villages locality. We appreciate the cost of a sensory room is extensive and feel that our bus would be a fantastic method of providing such means to young people.	£1,000	Funded
<b>Monkton Community Council</b>	This funding would enable us to provide a fitness group for the more senior members of our community, where they can participate in beneficial exercises in a controlled environment and be able to socialise over light refreshments and give them a place to focus on their own health and wellbeing.	£803	Funded
<b>Prestwick Business Association</b>	To help fund the installation of a cabinet defibrillator at Prestwick Toll. A cabinet defibrillator gives 24 hour access and will be registered with Scottish Ambulance Service. Using a defibrillator increases a person's chance of survival by 70% compared to CPR.	£1,000	Funded
<b>Spotty Zebras</b>	This funding would help us to fund a range of events over the Summer. Many of our families feel very isolated and stressed over the school holidays. By having regular activities throughout the Summer holidays, we are creating a safe and happy place for the whole family to attend and relax.	£280	Partially Funded
<b>Heathfield Community Centre</b>	To upgrade the water heater in our Centre's toilets to provide warm water for hand washing. Our group is volunteer based offering a range of activities within the centre, from new born babies to the elderly for fitness classes.	£1,000	Unsuccessful
<b>Prestwick Coastal Rowing Club</b>	To help fund our 'Rowing for All' project, to enable members of our community to improve their mental health & wellbeing through rowing. Our project will help to connect people, promote activity, teach new skills, and support mindfulness.	£780	Unsuccessful
<b>Prestwick Cricket Club</b>	To help fund a school's 5 week introduction to cricket coaching programme for several schools in the area. We will also purchase new equipment to help us deliver these sessions and others across the year.	£980	Unsuccessful
<b>Heathfield Primary School Parent Council</b>	To provide the opportunity for all children to experience an outdoor fitness obstacle challenge at a bespoke facility, which promotes self-esteem, builds confidence and encourages teamwork.
