<b>New Life Trust (Diamonds Befriending)</b>	To provide training for our bank of befrienders to ensure the service is carried out in the most professional and safe manner. The funding would also be used to purchase 4 mobile phones.	£3,000	Funded
<b>Monkton Senior Citizens</b>	To help fund our chair based exercise programme, as we need suitable chairs and resistance bands. It would also fund flyers and posters to promote the group.	£1,000	Funded
<b>Monkton Scottish Women's Rural Institute</b>	To help provide resources that will support our group to socialise, form friendships, learn new things and encourage new members.	£775	Funded
<b>St Ninian's Parent Council (Outdoor Activities)</b>	To purchase outdoor equipment for the pupils that will help support co-operative play, encourage physical activities and encourage pupils to interact with each other outside the classroom.	£1,000	Funded
<b>Symington Caledonian (Shaw Park Improvement Project)</b>	To improve drainage and revitalise the goalmouth areas, as well as reseed worn patches. This will improve the quality of the pitch and allow greater usage of the facility at Shaw Park.	£1,000	Funded

<b>South Ayrshire Escape from Homelessness - (SeAscape)</b> <b>(Pass it on Project)</b>	To help pilot a new project where free or low-cost goods in used, but good condition, will be sourced to pass on to clients within the Monkton, Prestwick Airport and Symington areas.	£500	Funded
<b>Symington Gala Committee</b>	To purchase gazebos, tables and chairs for our annual gala day. This equipment would enable village groups to hire a stall and raise funds for their groups.	£3,000	Funded
<b>Monkton Parent Council</b>	To help fund an Adventure Trail and permanent playground markings within the school grounds. This would benefit both nursery and school children, encouraging team work, co-ordination, confidence, physical health and fun.	£3,000	Funded
<b>South Ayrshire Active Schools</b>	To fund the training of local sports coaches who will help deliver sports programmes in Monkton and Symington. It will also help to fund the transport costs to get local children to and from sporting events.	£1,000	Funded
