Irvine & Troon Cancer Care	To help fund patient transport costs and volunteer driver's expenses. Drivers use their own cars to transport patients to and from hospital, they receive a mileage rate for each journey.	£1000	Funded
South Ayrshire Dementia Support Association	To help fund transport for people living with dementia who attend our day care in Prestwick. Our centre provides the chance to meet friends and encourage physical & mental stimulation, whilst providing respite for their main carer.	£1000	Funded
Good Companions	This funding will help subsidise/increase activities and events. Our club provides friendship, fun & interaction for local senior citizens. Activities include theatre nights, outings, musical evenings and theme nights.	£1,000	Funded
Walker Avenue Sheltered Housing	To enhance our facilities by providing a DVD & Lunch, gentle exercise group and nature talks, to promote health and wellbeing. This funding will purchase a 50 inch TV, wall bracket & sound bar.	£700	Funded
Loans Social Hub Drop In	To set up a 'Photo Therapy Group' to help those affected by mental health. To also establish a Loans Past & Present History Group and produce a DVD and film. This funding will purchase a projector, screen, sound bar and wall mount.	£960	Funded
Give A Dog A Bone	To help fund running/activities costs for our community space in Troon, which provides free activities for over 60s and free tea & chat service for anyone, to come and mix with our friendly team of Companionship Dogs.	£1,000	Funded
BSL Ayrshire	To provide bursaries for parents of deaf children and people who are themselves losing their hearing, to learn British Sign Language. To also offer free taster and top-up sessions in Troon.	£1,000	Funded
Dundonald Community Sports, Recreation & Heritage Association	This funding will help towards maintenance costs for the local playing field, to enable us to develop a Central Community Activity Hub with football, for male, female, youth & walking football, plus other sports & activities.	£1,000	Funded
Friends of Fullarton	To continue running working parties, walks & activities we require our committee members to have first aid certificates. Funding will be used for first aid training and help towards running costs and promotion of work parties & activities.	£680	Funded

Friends of Dundonald Castle	To help our community groups flourish by reaching more isolated individuals through outreach, presentations & talks e.g. sheltered housing, care homes & schools. To also provide talks, exhibitions & lunch club at our centre.	£1,000	Funded
Beautiful Inside & Out	Funding will be used to run two drop-in sessions per month in The Poppy Room coffee shop in Troon, one to promote positive well-being for anyone who is feeling troubled and one to support bereaved families of suicide victims.	£1,000	Funded
Barassie Primary Junior Road Safety Officers	To encourage participation in outdoor activities for pupils and wider community by creating a marked walking route for walking the "1/2k a'Day", cycling, scooting and interval training. Funding will enable us to design & install 2 permanent distance markers.	£500	Funded
National Autistic Society Troon Group	To enable us to hold a monthly social group for young autistic adults living in Troon & surrounding villages, bringing together vulnerable young autistic people and autistic adults who would otherwise be very isolated, through offering a range of community based activities.	£1,000	Funded
St Meddans Sheltered Housing	Funding will be used to purchase a Sonos smart screen speaker, karaoke resources and Nintendo wii console with wii sports, to enable us to provide weekly 'Music & Movement' classes for residents and wider community.	£774	Funded
Loans Community Council	To help purchase & install a defibrillator that is accessible to all people in Loans. The group will buy a secure cabinet for the defibrillator that will ensure that it is kept in the best possible condition.	£1000	Funded
1st Troon Girl's Brigade	To provide an inclusive free-of-charge residential activity based experience. The funding would cover accommodation, Centre staff-led activities, equipment and food.	£1000	Unsuccessful
Troon Harbour Community	Our 'Love Your Neighbour' project hopes to connect people in our local community through a range of activities including, 'Community Cabbie' scheme, coffee mornings, 'Improve Your Area' and seasonal community activities.
