1 st Troon Girls Brigade	To fund a 'free of charge' residential activity based experience for all girls allowing it to be fully inclusive. Funding would cover the cost of accommodation, activities, food and equipment.	£1,000	Funded
Troon Fairtrade Initiative	To provide schools and nurseries in Troon & District with Fairtrade footballs. Funding will help purchase 50 footballs.	£500	Funded
Cycle Ayrshire	To cover the costs of running the Ayrshire Cycling Festival; a weekend of cycling and bike-related activities. Funding would help pay for hire of the hall, publicity banners, printing material, goody bags for children, prizes and volunteer expenses.	£500	Funded
Irvine and Troon Cancer Care	To help fund ongoing patient transport costs and volunteer drivers expenses. The group provide a door to door service where patients are collected from their homes and taken to the hospital where the driver waits and brings them back home again.	£1,000	Funded
