Barassie Primary School - Nurture Group	To furnish a nurture classroom, and fund snacks and materials for baking and gardening. To also subsidise nurture group pupils to attend an 'Articulate' camp; which provides the opportunity to embed language teaching with motivating outdoor activities and other themes, such as Master Chef.	£1,600	Funded
Troon Allotment Society	To fund the fitting out of our on-site Community shed with cooking, heating, lighting and wheelchair access; which will provide a welcoming environment where members and visitors can enjoy a cup of tea/coffee or soup and have a chat with fellow members.	£3,000	Funded
Beautiful Inside and Out	To provide support for bereaved parents and siblings of suicide victims, as well as troubled souls; through counselling, music therapy and play therapy.	£1,000	Funded

Troon Water Sports Centre	To provide the project team with some working funds to organise and promote more “Come & Try” sessions. We plan to run six more over the next year with Wind Surfing, Rowing, and Stand Up Paddling, kiting and canoeing.	£1,000	Funded
St Patricks Primary School (Fundraising Group)	To purchase a gazebo for outings to parks, woods, beaches; allowing us to have a central base for the equipment and to promote the school to the communities we visit. To purchase playground games and resources, e.g. garden tools & magnifying glasses.	£1,000	Funded
Loans Community Centre Limited	To help fund the upgrading of the hall kitchen. This will include new kitchen units, cooker, plumbing and floor improvements. This will enhance the hall and not only help to maintain its present use but also attract new lets.	£3,000	Funded
