

LAND REFORM (SCOTLAND) ACT 2003

THE SOUTH AYRSHIRE COUNCIL (ROYAL TROON GOLF COURSE 152nd OPEN) EXEMPTING LAND FROM ACCESS RIGHTS (NO. 1) ORDER, 2024

SOUTH AYRSHIRE COUNCIL (“the Council”), in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 11(1) of the Land Reform (Scotland) Act 2003 (“the Act”) and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, having consulted the owner of the land to which the order relates, and the local access forum, and any other person they consider appropriate, having given public notice of the intended purpose and effect of the order, and having considered any objections and representations made to them, all in accordance with section 11(2) of the Act, hereby make the following order:

- 1 This Order may be cited as “The South Ayrshire Council (Royal Troon Golf Course 152nd Open) Exempting Land from Access Rights (No. 1) Order, 2024”.
- 2 The effect of the Order is to exempt the area of land shown outlined and hatched red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto (the “Plan”), including a section of the core path at the Wrack Road (Smugglers Trail/ core path SA6/ public right of way SKC28) (“core path”), comprising part of Royal Troon Golf Course, South Ayrshire, from the access rights which would otherwise be exercisable in respect of that land by virtue of Part 1 of the Act.
3. An alternative route for the section of the core path referred to in paragraph 2 above will be provided along the route shown by a broken blue line on the Plan.
- 4 The purposes for which the Order is made are:
 - (a) to secure the health and safety of the public and construction workers, and the security of materials and supplies, during the installation and dismantling of temporary structures and services, before and after the Open Golf Championship 2024 (the “Championship”); and
 - (b) to secure the safety and security of players and the safety of the public during the Championship.
- 5 The Order will take effect from 0.00 hours on 25 March 2024 - or on the date on which it is confirmed by the Scottish Ministers, if later - and will expire at 23.59 hours on 6 September 2024, unless revoked earlier.

The foregoing Order, together with the Plan annexed and signed as relative hereto, are subscribed for and on behalf of South Ayrshire Council by their Head of Legal and Regulatory Services, an authorised signatory and proper officer of the local authority in terms of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 section 193 as amended, at AYR on 8 December 2023
