Kellie lynch wished to have it noted that the TUSK team had never said that they 'owned' the skatepark, but she stated it was the busiest facility within the town, and that the post was in poor taste and that a community group was named and shamed. She stated that they had only been a community group trying to keep the skate park clean and decent facility for people to use. D Carson – was not aware of any post.

M Leonard said TDT had been contacted by members of the public and that they were asking the question in regards to the skate park. Also were asking why there was going to be an extension to the skate park when children were suffering. She explained that it was nothing to do with TDT and that it is possibly the council that were approving the extension, therefore the question should be raised with the 4 ward councillors. TDT only take what the people of Troon want.

Cllr bell stated that in summer 23 it was envisaged that if the skate park was successful they would extend this to a pump track and this is what is being looked at being approved.

Cllr Mackay stated that there maybe needs to be some transparency as to where the post came from as he was not sure of this. He also said it was not very constructive. Comms possibly? Cllrs did say they would check in to this.

John Crera – came to ask about a piece of ground between Walker Hall and the kiosk at the south beach and what is going to happen with this as it is an eyesore and seems to be left only for the big wheel in summer, can this be looked at by cllrs. Cllr mackay will look in to this matter.
