I refer to the Extended Hours application submitted for the above premises which is situated in Templehill, Troon -

The application requests a terminal hour of 3.30am for one night/morning on Sunday 8th February, which would, if granted, permit the sale of alcohol from 12noon on that day allowing a total of 15.5 hours.

Currently the trading hours for these premises allow a terminal hour of 2.30am on a Sunday and therefore this application requests an additional 1 hours trading, however due to the terminal hour this application must be determined at a Board meeting.

The applicant has advised that the purpose of this application is to cater to the increasing interest in the Superbowl in the area and to offer a venue in Troon as the others that have already been granted extended hours by the Board are based in Ayr and Prestwick.

Through discussion with the applicant, I understand that this will be a ticketed event although there will be no charge for entry, as this will allow the premises to control the entry numbers and ensure that attendees are aware of the event and staffing numbers can be organised in advance.

I understand there will be snack food provided to ensure those in attendance are eating as well as drinking and there will be décor and a theme to suit the Superbowl final, which will be shown on all of the screens within the venue.

Members will be aware that the Board have already granted extended hours to premises who are organising a special event on the premises for those who wish to watch the Superbowl final.

With the above in mind and being aware that the applicant is an experienced operator who is regularly granted additional hours and already has relevant practices in place as a late night operator, I have no objections to the extended hours as requested.
