Who are we?

- The pavilion has been left unused (since COVID) and has now fallen in to a poor state of repair.

Our Plans

- ✓ Full repairs, additional windows and an enhanced exterior
- ✓ Large social space which will be available to other community groups.
- ✓ Small craft workshop with soundproofing and restricted operating times to minimise noise.
- ✓ Air source heat-pumps, solar panels & insulation to be part of the energy efficient design.
- ✓ Avoid conflicts with sporting fixtures. Much lower traffic levels compared to football days.
- ✓ We are aiming to complete the refurbishment around autumn 2026.
