6. South Ayrshire Councillors Cllr Connolly was asked if the Buddleia at the former original coop site could be cleared. No owner can be identified for the site. Hit Squad at SAC can also be contacted with suggestions on areas that require attention with regards to litter. Layby near academy also requires attention. SG asked Cllr Connolly if hedges at Greenside were going to be removed as part of the £2 Million additional regeneration fund. Cllr Connolly said that all proposals in regards to the fund will go through full public consultation by Summer. Miller Park issue has to go through procurement for completion within the next couple of months. SM asked about 20mph zone in Minishant and whether this was enforceable. SG referred to PC Green's earlier statement at a previous meeting that 20mph zones are not routinely enforced by Police except in School Zones.
