Community Matters

Donations. Discussions took place about donations to be agreed with Floyds, Scouts, Dundonald Castle, Highland Games, Toddlers Groups discussed. There are also volunteers who tidy and litter pick around village, and woods. Trolley was provided at a cost of £109. Litter around garage discussed however this site being taken over by hairdresser, and the car park is Council.
