Parking Areas

Never clean out your horsebox or trailer in a car park, layby or onto a path. If your horse dungs while tied up outside your vehicle, pick it up and take it home with you.

If your horse dungs on a multi-use or shared path (especially if used by cyclists, buggies or wheelchairs) it is courteous and responsible to: position your horse at the side of the path to dung, if possible; or, dismount and kick the dung to the side of the path,

Horse Fouling Although there is no legislation requiring a rider to pick up their horse's dung, often it is a sensible and considerate move, which could preserve a riding route in the future.

Responsible Riding Riding on firm, well-drained paths usually causes few problems. On multi-use or shared routes be aware that some people are afraid of horses, so give way to other users and be ready to take an alternative route if necessary.

Riding on Beaches in Ayrshire

Ayr, Greenan and Irvine beaches are all brilliant for riding, but tend to be very busy when the weather is good over summer; during which time riders are advised to enjoy the beaches early morning or evening. Irvine beach has a large car park suitable for trailers and horse boxes. Remember to check the local tide times.

Beach etiquette:

 Slow your pace to walk and allow plenty of space when passing other people; If you want to go fast, choose a time and/or beach which is likely to be quiet; Do not ride accompanied by your dog on busy beaches, and even on quiet beaches, make sure you keep your dog at heel when

- passing other people; Follow signs and local guidance aimed at
- reducing dune erosion or avoiding
- disturbance of nesting birds.
