COVID-19 Asymptomatic Testing Site is available in Maybole.

Residents who don't have any of the three COVID-19 symptoms (a new and continuous cough; high temperature; loss or change in sense of taste or smell) will soon be able to get a rapid coronavirus (COVID-19) test.

You don't need to book, and testing will be available at the following location until Sunday 15 August:

- Maybole Town Hall, High Street, Maybole KA19 7BZ -10.00am – 6.00pm

This site is only for people without symptoms. Anyone with COVID-19 symptoms should book a test in the usual way via www.nhsinform.scot or by calling 0800 028 2816.
