With regards the hedge cutting, AC pointed out the restrictions in place to protect nesting birds and the guidance is to not cut until 1st Sept. However, for safety of pavement users this is not acceptable.

At this time the general consensus from the village with regards controlling the speed of traffic coming down Station Road is physical traffic calming rather than just markings and signs. We are still waiting to hear back from Ayrshire Roads Alliance with regards the proposed 20mph scheme.

Kevin Braidwood (ARA) continues to look for funding to repair and make safe the pavements.

Marc McCrindle had asked about a community skip which other local villages have the use of. MM going to ask the question.

MM going to look in to whether DCC has a link officer allocated to it from SAC.
MM highlight there are new funds going to be made available, but details are scarce.
Applications must be submitted by 7th October and spent by 28th February 2023. She will advise.
