### Who is a young carer?

- Someone under the age of 18 who helps look after someone who is ill, disabled, elderly, has trouble communicating, mental health issues, neurodivergent, or has issues with drugs or alcohol.
- This can be a relative, friend or neighbour they don't have to live in the same home.
- There is no minimum caring requirement.
- Young carers can look after more than one person.
- They may not be the primary carer.
- Some young carers may have health issues of their own and can also be cared for.
- Some start caring at a very young age and don't know they are carers. Some become carers overnight.



### Roles & Responsibilities

- Practical tasks
- Physical care
- Emotional support
- Personal care
- Managing budgets
- Helping someone communicate
- Looking after siblings
- And more...



### Possible signs

- Often tired, anxious or withdrawn
- Secretive about their home life
- Lack of confidence/low selfesteem
- Bullied/isolated from peers
- Lack concentration/easily distracted
- Often appears to be worried about a loved one
- Having difficulty in joining in extra curricular activities or is unable to attend school trips
- Behavioural issues
- Showing signs of neglect



#### Barriers

- Staff knowledge/confidence
- Young person's knowledge
- Stigma
- Fear of consequences
- Parents

### In South Ayrshire

1 in 5 children in a class has a caring role

Based on this, there are almost 3,000 young carers in South Ayrshire

We currently have **120** identified

96% are hidden.
