- 3. If the election is contested, voting will take place between 7.00 am and 10.00 pm on **Thursday 21 September 2023**.
- 4. Applications to register to vote **must** reach the Electoral Registration Officer at 9 Wellington Square, Ayr, KA7 1HL, by **12.00 midnight** on **Tuesday 5 September 2023**. Applications can be made online: https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.

Postal or proxy voting

- 1. Any elector may apply for a postal or proxy vote at this election.
- 2. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes **must** reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the above address, by 5.00 pm on Wednesday 6 September 2023.
- 3. Applications to vote by proxy at this election **must** reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the above address by 5.00 pm on Wednesday 13 September 2023.
- 4. Applications to amend or cancel existing proxy arrangements **must** reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the above address by 5.00 pm Wednesday 6 September 2023.
- 5. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election ie made after the **Wednesday 13 September 2023** deadline on the grounds of: a medical issue or disability suffered after that deadline (or, for applicants who suffered a medical issue or disability before the deadline, their medical issue or disability meant that they could not reasonably have made an application in time), work/ service reasons, being detained in a hospital under the civil sections of the Mental Health (Care and Treatment) (Scotland) Act 2003 or for Scottish prisoners serving a sentence of 12 months or less, **must** reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the above address by 5.00 pm on Thursday 21 September 2023.

To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5.00 pm on Wednesday 13 September 2023.
