

LAND REFORM (SCOTLAND) ACT 2003

THE SOUTH AYRSHIRE COUNCIL (ROYAL TROON GOLF COURSE, AIG WOMEN'S BRITISH OPEN) EXEMPTING LAND FROM ACCESS RIGHTS ORDER 2020

SOUTH AYRSHIRE COUNCIL ("the Council"), in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 11(1) of the Land Reform (Scotland) Act 2003 ("the Act"), in order to exempt land from access rights otherwise exercisable under the Act - having consulted Royal Troon Golf Club as the owner of the land to which the order relates, the South Ayrshire Local Access Forum, Troon Community Council, the elected members of South Ayrshire Council for the affected ward and the Ayrshire Rotary Coastal Path Route Manager; having given public notice of the intended purpose and effect of the order; and having considered any objections and representations made to it, all in accordance with section 11(2) of the Act - hereby makes the following Order:

- 1 This Order may be cited as "The South Ayrshire Council (Royal Troon Golf Course, AIG Women's British Open) Exempting Land from Access Rights Order 2020".
- 2 The effect of the Order is to exempt the area of land comprising Royal Troon Golf Course (excluding the Ayrshire Coastal Path) from the access rights which would otherwise be exercisable in respect of that land by virtue of Part 1 of the Act.
- 3 The purpose for which the Order is made is to enable the AIG Women's British Open golf championship to be held, with the land being proposed specifically for temporary exemption from access rights, in the interests of the safety and security of participating players and the safety of staff and the public, during the Championship.
- 4 The Order will take effect from 12.00 (midday) hours on 15 August 2020 - or the date on which it is confirmed by the Scottish Ministers, if later - and will expire at 11:59 (am) hours on 25 August 2020.
