TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL DEVELOPMENT) (SCOTLAND) ORDER 1975  
KYLE AND CARRICK DISTRICT COUNCIL

(AYR CENTRAL, AYR NO. 2 AND ST. QUIVOX CONSERVATION AREAS) DIRECTION 1981

In exercise of the powers conferred on them by paragraph 1 of Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning (General Development)(Scotland) Order 1975, the District Council of Kyle and Carrick hereby give the following Direction -

- (1) That the permission granted in terms of Article 3(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Development)(Scotland) Order 1975, shall not apply to the development of the classes specified in the Schedule hereto to the areas delineated and shown within the boundaries coloured red on the Plans numbered 1, 2 and 3 annexed and subscribed as relative to this Direction unless permission is granted on an application in that behalf.
- (2) That the Town and Country Planning Kyle and Carrick District Council (Conservation Areas) Direction 1976 is hereby revoked, but only to the extent to which it applies to the Ayr Central and Ayr No. 2 Conservation Areas.
- (3) This Direction may be cited as the Town and Country Planning Kyle and Carrick District Council (Ayr Central, Ayr No. 2 and St. Quivox Conservation Areas) Direction 1981.

Made by the Provost and Councillors of Kyle and Carrick District Council  
on the Eighth day of January, Nineteen hundred and Eighty one.

SCHEDULE

Class I - Development within the curtilage of a dwellinghouse.

Class II - Sundry minor operations.

Class IV - Temporary buildings and uses.

Class XV - Development by statutory undertakers.

Class XXI(C) - Development by planning authorities (where estimated cost does not exceed £25,000)

Class XXII - Use as caravan sites.

The Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Article 4(2) of the Town and Country Planning (General Development)(Scotland) Order 1981 hereby approves the foregoing Town and Country Planning Kyle and Carrick District Council (Ayr Central, Ayr No 2 and St Quivox Conservation Areas) Direction 1981 subject to the following modifications:

1. In the preamble to the Direction with reference to the Town and Country Planning (General Development)(Scotland) Order there shall be substituted "1981" in place of "1975".
2. Paragraph 1 of the Direction shall now read as follows:  
"(1) That the permission granted in terms of Article 3(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Development)(Scotland) Order 1981, shall not apply to the development of the classes specified in the Schedule hereto to the extent specified therein in respect of the areas delineated and shown within the boundaries coloured red and green on the Plans numbered 1, 2 and 3 annexed and subscribed as relative to this Direction".
3. Plan numbered 1 referred to in paragraph 1 of the said Direction shall show thereon an area delineated in green.
4. The Schedule to the Direction shall read as follows:

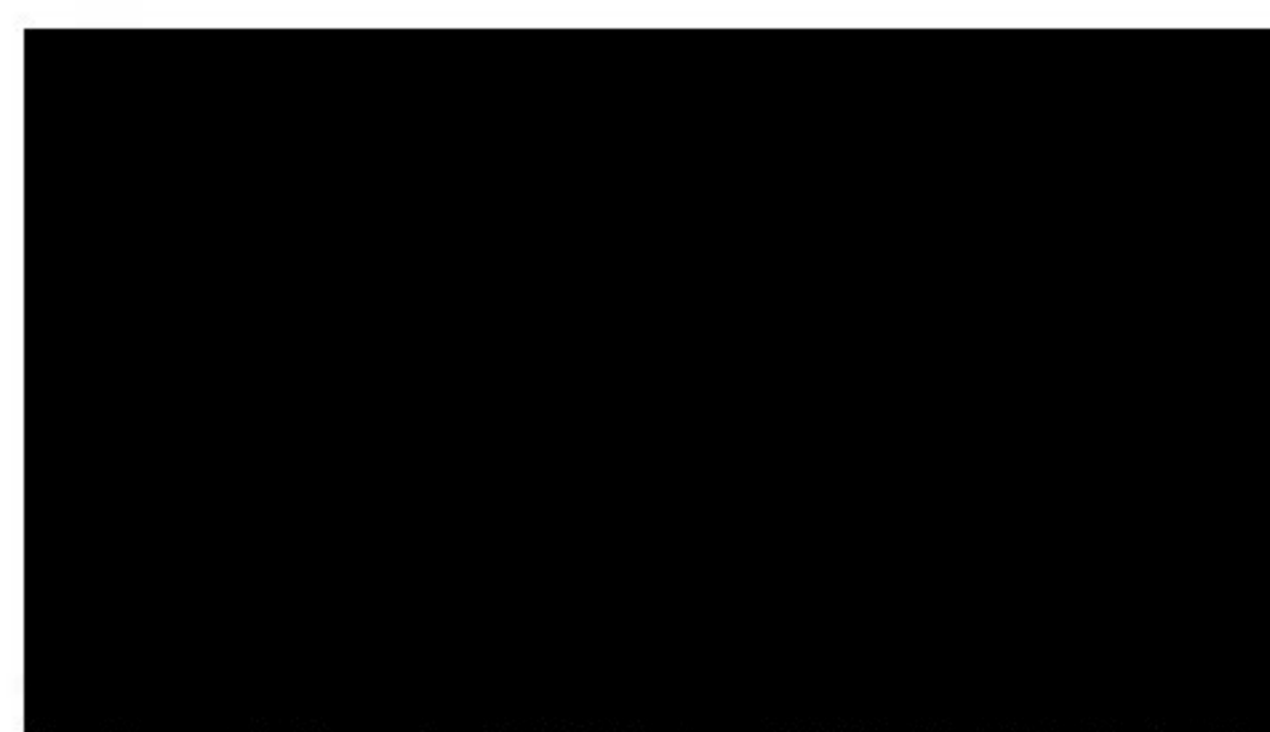
